# Fire Related Product Recall Notice

## Ford Fiesta ST, Kuga, Model years 2013-2014

Ford Motor Company has issued a recall of the above models over a potential fire risk.

#### Problem

In all of the affected vehicles, localized overheating of the engine cylinder head, due to a lack of coolant circulation, may cause the cylinder head to crack causing an oil leak that may result in a fire in the engine compartment.

### **Details**

Fiesta ST 2013 & 2014, Kuga 2013 & 2014

#### What to do

Check the engine coolant level regularly. Customers should see their dealer if their vehicle exhibits a coolant leak or overheating or frequently needs coolant added.

Initial letters will be mailed as soon as possible to all recorded Kuga owners advising of the 2 -Stage repair process supporting parts availability in the 2nd quarter 2017 and 4th quarter 2017. Initial letters will be mailed to all recorded Fiesta ST owners advising of the 2 - Stage repair process and parts availability as soon as possible.
