Lenovo ThinkPad Computer Batteries	
05 March 2007	ACTION - New Zealand recall
Problem	The batteries can overheat and cause a fire if they are struck forcefully.
Details	<p>9-cell lithium-ion batteries sold with (or sold separately to be used with) the following Lenovo ThinkPad notebook computers:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• ThinkPad R60 and R60e series• ThinkPad T60 and T60p series• ThinkPad Z60m, Z61e, Z61m, and Z61p series <p>Only 9-cell batteries with the part number FRU P/N 92P1131 are being recalled.</p> <p>The batteries were manufactured for use with ThinkPad notebook computers that shipped worldwide between November 2005 and February 2007.</p> <p><i>See the Lenovo website to check if your battery is part of the recall.</i></p>
What to do	<p>Stop using the recalled batteries and order a free replacement either online or contact Lenovo on 0800 426 7378.</p> <p>Until a replacement battery arrives, if you intend to transport your computer or use it in a manner that may subject it to strong external impact, you should turn off the system, remove the battery and only power the computer with the AC adapter and power cord.</p>
