ACTION - New Zealand recall

Problem	It is possible for the batteries to overheat, which could pose a risk of fire.
Details	<p>Sony 2.15Ah Lithium Ion batteries used in Hewlett-Packard, Toshiba and Dell notebook computers. What to do	Immediately remove the recalled battery from the computer, and request a free replacement battery through the company's website. After removing the recalled battery, the AC adapter can be used to power the computer until a replacement battery arrives.
