Problem

The product is being recalled because the risk for overheating. This has led to some units smoking or catching fire.

Details

The affected Weiss Heat Transfer Units models are FV 602, FV603, FV652, and FV 653. These units were sold at Mitre 10 stores and other retailers prior to May 2012.



What to do

Consumers should immediately stop using any Weiss Heat Transfer System immediately. Turn the system off and contact Weiss New Zealand on 0800 208 008 or a registered electrician.
