Problem	A wire connector may overheat, causing plastic to melt or in extreme cases, a small fire in the control panel.
Details	 Westinghouse dishwasher models affected: SB908WK SB908SK SB916WK SB916SK SB926SK With serial numbers between 70700000 to 72400000. Sold after June 2007. The model and serial numbers can be found on the front right hand inner door panel.
What to do	Do not operate the dishwasher when unattended, or use the delayed start program. Switch it off at the power point when the cycle has been completed, until it has been checked. With the model and serial number handy call Westinghouse on 0800 277 542 to register your details, between 8.30am and 5.00pm Monday to Friday. Electrolux, the manufacturer of Westinghouse dishwashers, will arrange for a service technician to call free of charge.
