## Welcome

The meeting began with a karakia and a welcome. An introduction was done of new Senior Advisor, Shane Laulu who will be supporting the West Coast Local Advisory Committee (LAC).

#### **Minutes**

The minutes from the Committee's meeting on 12 September 2023 were confirmed.

## **Chairs Hui Update**

The Chair updated the Committee on the Chairs' hui that took place on 31 October 2023 in Wellington. The Chair provided the Committee with a summary of discussions that occurred at the hui. LAC Chairs worked to identify common themes from each LAC's insights report to develop the national-level Chairs' Insights Report. The Chair also highlighted the desire from LAC Chairs to strengthen the feedback loop on insights from the organisation and understanding the needs of vulnerable communities was a big point of discussion between the LAC Chairs present.

## **Workplan and Insights Reporting**

The Chair and LAC discussed the content of the 2023-2024 workplan and development of the stakeholder register. The Principal Advisor suggested referencing the Northland LAC template to assist with the development of the LACs stakeholder engagement register.

## **Community engagement**

The Committee engaged with the Buller District Council and discussed the value of Fire and Emergency providing a submission at the district level to the Council's Long-Term Plan.

The Committee acknowledged the District Manager for arranging Fire Chiefs meeting.

Further engagements are planned and noted in the action log below.

#### **District update**

District Manager provided an update on recent staff movements and retirement. The Moana station rebuilding programme is continuing with the completion time possibly delayed. Several Fire and Emergency district personnel attended the conference on leadership development. The District Manager will be attending the volunteer recruit course graduation ceremony on 15 December 2023.

District continues to manage its volunteer support recruitment and retention challenges and are aiming to recruit up to 50 new volunteers for the West Coast over the coming period.

## **National LAC Team update**

The National LAC Team updated the Committee on new recruits to the team – Shane Laulu (Senior Advisor) and Kate Adams (Coordinator).

Along with the West Coast LAC, Shane will also support the Northland and Marlborough LACs and Kate is assisting Sally McKay with logistics and secretariat support.

LAC Terms of Reference (ToR) variance (from the existing ToR to the revised version) was explained to the Committee.

#### **Board quarterly report**

The Committee agreed on the content of its quarter two report to the Board.

Discussion on LAC engagement with stakeholders and associated risk of not being able to provide useful feedback to follow-up on local community engagements. Noted as action from the discussion was inclusion in the quarter two insight report to highlight risk to LAC members with the on-going trust and confidence of the community to share insight with Fire and Emergency without tangible impact.

For inclusion into the quarter two report to the Board, is the engagement with Buller District Council, which highlighted the following:

- Acknowledgment of Fire and Emergency being able to resource outside flooding events, although noted Fire and Emergency wasn't involved in debrief.
- Concern raised there wasn't a Volunteer Support Officer for some brigades in the district, given the volunteer representation of the area, and the need for the provision of support for younger volunteers, induction process, and health and wellness.

Future meeting dates and venues were discussed and agreed.
