Welcome

The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting, which was opened with a karakia tīmatanga. Introductions and whanaungatanga were carried out.

Committee operations

There were amendments to the members register of interests. These were recorded and noted.

The minutes of the LACs previous meeting on 26 November 2024 were confirmed by the Committee with minor amendments. There was discussion on the content of minutes and recording discussions to note the development of decisions. Action points were reviewed and updated.

The Senior Advisor LACs provided an update of the community perceptions research undertaken by Verian.

The LAC reviewed its monthly online chat with District leadership team and concludes it is of value and a continuing benefit.

Chair's update

The Chair provided a brief update of the recent Chairs Forum in and dialogue with the Board in November.

Review of LACs engagement plan

The LAC reviewed the engagement plan and reports submitted via Whāriki for the period. Members provided updates from their areas of engagement.

The LAC workshopped their engagement plan focus and priorities for Trimester Three. These include; Iwi (Ngāti Kahungunu), education and volunteerism.

An analysis of the LAC's engagement reports:

- indicated support for Firewise prevention programme in schools and appreciation of the programme's value with children taking messaging home.
- noting potential education on the organisation's structure for brigades that were previously natural brigades under the previous structure. This will be something to explore in engagement with brigades by the LAC

The Chair will seek advice from other LAC Chairs on engagement with Iwi/Hapu and how this may guide the LAC's local engagement approach.

The LAC and Pou Takawaenga will liaise post meeting on connecting with Iwi/Hapu and ethnic communities in the district.

District update

The District Manager gave an update and overview on current issues for the District. The priority for the District in coming year is focusing internally on its firemanship including safety health and wellbeing, natural hazard response planning with partner agencies in support of community resilience, and brigades' capability and capacity.

The LAC was briefed on region and district priorities, the district plan 2025/26 including the key performance indicators, along with identified challenges, risks, issues, and future work.

The District is working on a major risk assessment for the area. High impact low occurrence events, wildfire, and workforce planning are key features of the risk assessment.

The District Manager shared a video on fire safety aimed for Recognised Seasonal Employers (RSE) and workers featuring local staff that is being used as a tool nationally.

Future Operational Capability briefing

Chris Lind from the Future Operational Capability project updated the committee on the project and timelines. The committee was invited to provide feedback to the project team via email: futureoperationalcapability@fireandemergency.nz

The Senior Advisor provided an update on the Whāriki engagement reporting tool rollout. The LAC discussed tool and went through the online form and hardcopy provided for members.
