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Information Request – White Fleet Numbers

We refer to your official information request dated 3 July 2023. This request was transferred to Fire and Emergency New Zealand by the Department of Internal Affairs on 4 July 2023. You requested the following information:

Could you please tell me how many?

- 1. FENZ unmarked response capable Managers Cars there are
- 2. FENZ marked response capable Utes that are attached to roles there are, such as Volunteer support officers, group managers, fire safety etc

We interpreted your request as asking for (1) the number of response capable vehicles (including cars, utes, and SUVs) that do not have branding and are driven by a manager and (2) the number of response capable utes that do have Fire and Emergency branding and are attached to specific roles. We interpreted "response capable" to mean fitted with emergency beacons and siren.

Your request has been assessed in accordance with the provisions of the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA). We provide the following answers to your request:

- The number of response capable unmarked vehicles driven by managers is 80.
- The number of response capable marked utes that are attached to specific roles is 79.

Please note that we do not have a database that records this specific information, so we have provided an answer based on local knowledge from the Region Fleet Coordinators and some checking of other information sources.
